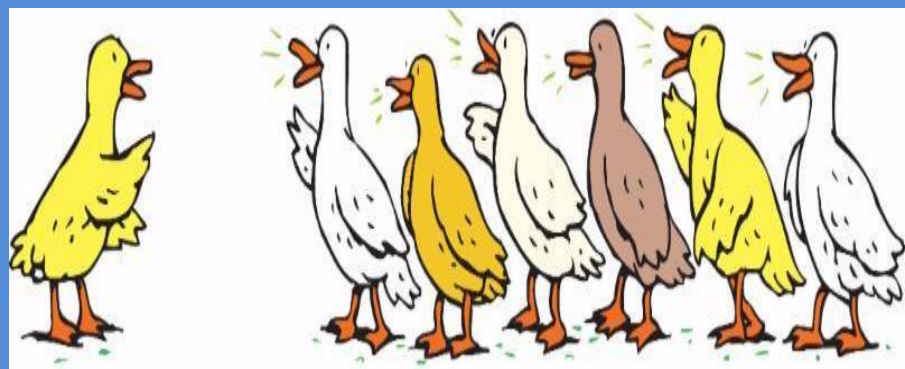

In McHenry County text "MCHELP" to 274637 to receive help.
