Shepherd has weathered the storm and the flooding. We pray you have too. There are leaks in our roof but our foundation is solid.

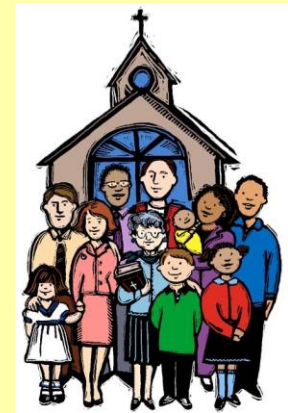

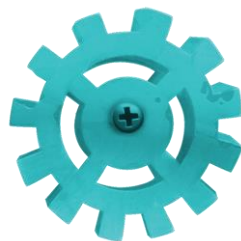
